Solo and Ensemble Festival – Monday, March 27th – NON Honor Band Participants

1:00pm – Leave Homer High School with Wendy Bales for Soldotna High School

3:00pm – Arrive at Soldotna High School for Festival

3:15-5:15pm – Perform in Solo and Ensemble, listen to other participants

5:15pm – Pack up, go to Fred Meyer for food, and then head home

~7:30pm – Arrive back at Homer High School

Mass Band Festival – Tuesday, March 28th – ALL BAND STUDENTS

6:30am – Arrive at HHS to load the bus for prompt departure at 6:40 (we must load stands and percussion equipment onto the bus)

8:30am – Arrive at Kenai Central High School for rehearsal

9:00am-3pm – Rehearse with Guest Conductors, Lunch, More Rehearsal

3:15pm-5:15pm – Break for dinner (Fred Meyer/Taco Bell)

5:15-6:00pm – Prepare for concert

6:00pm – Concert Begins

~8:00pm – Concert Ends, Pack Bus and Head Home

~9:30-10:00pm – Arrive back at HHS (students will call when we pass through Anchor Point)

Before leaving, students need to pay their Mass Band Festival Fee of \$30 (covers travel and clinician costs). If participating in Solo and Ensemble, students need to pay their \$25/entry fee (which covers accompanist costs and the clinician costs).

Students need to bring:

- -Instrument, Music, Extra Reeds/Valve Oil, etc
- -All parts of their uniform
- -Sack lunch or money for lunch (Free/Reduced Lunch will be available) only F/R Lunch students will be able to enter their account number, ALL other students must bring cash
- -Sack dinner or money for dinner

This event is an important aspect of the KPBSD Music Curriculum, and as such, all students are expected to attend. Students who do not attend will have a make-up assignment that is designed to take the same amount of time for the rehearsal, as well as a performance assignment for the concert. I do, however, reserve the right to leave students home who do not demonstrate adequate discipline or preparation in class, or are failing a majority of their classes.

If you are willing to travel as a chaperone, please let me know as soon as possible, and make sure that you have filled out the appropriate form on the District Webpage.
