

## **Mass Band Information – Tuesday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>**

This event is where all of the middle school bands in the Kenai Peninsula gather (this year at Homer High) to perform a joint concert. Students will miss the entire day of school on May 2<sup>nd</sup> for rehearsal, and then perform a concert at 6pm Tuesday night. This is required for all students.

Students must be at the **high school** by 8:30am on May 2<sup>nd</sup>. Rehearsal will be done by 3:00pm.

*Morning Bus Information:* All busses except RT 65 already go to HHS. Students who ride RT 65 will be taken to HHS after the bus makes its final drop off at HHS.

*Afternoon Bus Information:* All busses except 65 come to HHS, so students will get on their normal bus. Students who take RT 65 will need to be on the first bus from HHS (RT 60) to take that bus to HMS, where they will get on RT 65. Students may stay at HHS for track practice.

If your student does not take the bus, please plan to pick them up at the high school at the end of the day. Students will be able to get hot lunch at the high school, or can bring a lunch of their own. If you are interested in helping out on the day of Mass Band, please let me know and make sure that you have filled out the HMS Volunteer Application on the District Website no later Tuesday, April 25<sup>th</sup>.

**Call time for the concert will be 5:15pm.**

*There is a fee of \$10 for participation in this event.* This fee goes to cover the cost of bringing in the clinician and purchasing new music for the students to play. Please send the fee in as soon as possible in an envelope with your student's name on it. They may turn it into the office or Mrs. Johnson.

This is a District Concert, so there will be a Gate Charge to get in. The District has set the gate charge as \$5/adults, \$3/senior citizens, \$2/students, and \$15/families. The gate charge goes to help off-set the travel costs of the other schools.
